Incidents

On October 6th, Officers responded to a report of glass bottles breaking in the area of Meadow Lane. Upon arrival, it as determined to be an underage drinking party. Officers ended the gathering, contacted the homeowner and all involved parents were notified.

On October 20th, Officer Petersen responded to Glendale Street for a report of Malicious Destruction to Motor Vehicle's. A resident reported that the tires on both of his vehicles had been slashed, the interior had been rummaged through, and the lawnmowers in the rear of one of the vehicles also had their tires slashed. The incident is under investigation.

On the second day, at Mill and Main Place Officers and Dispatchers participated in a classroom portion and active shooter drills. The newly hired Public Safety Dispatcher, Paula Brodeur, attended a 40 hour APCO Basic Telecommunicator course in Maynard as well as a 16 hour E911 certification course.
