## Incidents

The Maynard Police Department Detectives have been investigating a series of thefts from businesses inside of the Mill and Main Place buildings.

In November 12<sup>th</sup> Maynard Police and Animal Control were called to the Maynard Dog Park for a reported of a male that was bitten by a dog. There had been a fight between two dogs, and one of the owners had been bitten. He was transported and treated at an area hospital. The matter was turned over to Animal Control.

On November 19<sup>th</sup>, Detective Manchuso had the NEMLEC K9's perform a sweep at the Maynard High School.

The Maynard Police Department responded to reports of five package thefts from the Stone Bridge Condominiums. The thefts are under investigation.

As October came to a close, the total for the Pink Patch Project reached \$820.00! The Maynard Police Department is proud to make a sizeable donation to Breast Cancer research. We could not have done it without our wonderful supporters! Thank you to you.

On November 26<sup>th</sup>, we received a photo, video and nice message from one of our followers on Facebook. Officer Moore and Special Officer Banatoski stopped to play football with some neighborhood children while out on Patrol. It happened to be caught on camera, and we will be pleased to receive the positive message! Although, we know acts like this happen often, they aren't always caught on camera. We were thrilled to be able to see our Officers interacting with the youth in Maynard.

November brought forth another fantastic cause, No Shave November. Chief Dubois allows the staff of the Maynard Police Department to grow facial hair, for a \$100.00 donation to the Home Base Foundation which helps Service Members, Veterans and their families heal from the invisible wounds. There were 13 Officers that participated, and \$1,300.00 was raised in donations.

Chief Dubois kindly extended No Shave November into No Shave December, allowing Officers to keep their facial hair for the month of December for an additional \$100.00 donation to the Home Base Foundation. We have four Officers that have chosen to take part, raising another \$400.00 additional dollars. This raises our contribution to a total of \$1,700.00.
