## Incidents

On February 7<sup>th</sup> 2019, at 1 Acton Court, multi-jurisdictional investigation resulted in the arrest of two suspects and recovery of one firearm. Authorities from the Maynard Police Department, Massachusetts State Police and ATF responded to the residence at approximately 7:15AM and with the assistance of the Northeastern Massachusetts Law Enforcement Council (NEMLEC) SWAT team a high-risk warrant was served. The need for the specialized training and abilities of a SWAT team was demonstrated by information garnered during the investigation that indicated the possible presence of firearms in the home. Two males, one adult and one teenage juvenile were taken into custody, and one firearm was recovered during the initial investigation. No one was injured in the operation, and the SWAT team cleared the scene shortly before 1 p.m.

“We are very fortunate to have such amazing law enforcement partners in Massachusetts, including our local ATF branch, the state police, and the highly trained municipal police officers that make up the NEMLEC SWAT team,” Chief Dubois said. “Thanks to an efficient and orderly operation today, two dangerous suspects have been taken into custody.”

On February 25<sup>th</sup>, the Maynard Police Department received two transferred E911 calls that provided almost no information, and a very vague location. Officers, specifically Officer Comeau, were dispatched to the area in search of the caller. Officer Comeau was able to locate a person who was actively attempting suicide, he intervened and rendered aid until the arrival of EMS. Because of Officer Comeau’s dedication and efforts, this person is now receiving treatment. We are very proud of Officer Comeau’s efforts.
