Incidents

On March 8th, Officer Brennan responded to El Huipil Restaurant to take a report of a vehicle that had possibly been “keyed”. The incident is under investigation, and video footage of the area is being reviewed.

In the area of 187 Main Street on March 16th, the operator of a vehicle reported a hit and run accident. The reporting party stated that a driver crashed into the drivers side of his vehicle, stopped briefly to speak with him and left the scene. Officer Seeley received a description of the vehicle and operator. The information was provided to surrounding cities and towns with a description of the damage. The crash is under investigation.

On March 25th at approximately 1:30AM, Officer Comeau was dispatched to 7-11 for a report of possible credit card misuse. The cardholder name, and the individual making a purchase did not match. Upon further investigation, it was confirmed that the cardholder had given this individual permission to make a purchase with the debit card.

On March 18th we received a 911 call from a 10 year old boy reporting that his grandmother was choking. He remained calm, and did a great job requesting help for his grandmother, who is making a recovery after Sergeant Duggan and Officer Seeley performed the Heimlich Maneuver, and MFD worked her. This 10 year old, Zander Clark, will be receiving awards on April 16th for the life saving 911 call that he placed.
