Incidents

On Sunday, Sept. 15, police responded to the Corner Store on Walnut Street at approximately 9 p.m. for a report of an armed robbery. Upon arrival, police learned that a man had entered the store, pointed a handgun at the clerk and demanded money. The suspect then left the store with an undetermined quantity of cash. No one was injured in the incident. The suspect is described as a white male, approximately 5'5" tall, with a slender build. He was wearing a black hooded sweatshirt at the time of the robbery. The Maynard Police Department is making video surveillance footage from the robbery available, with the hope that someone will recognize the suspect and provide information leading to his identification and capture. Upon arrival Officers observed a small amount of damage to the screen door. Officers spoke with residents who had been outside, and conducted a search of the area with negative results.
